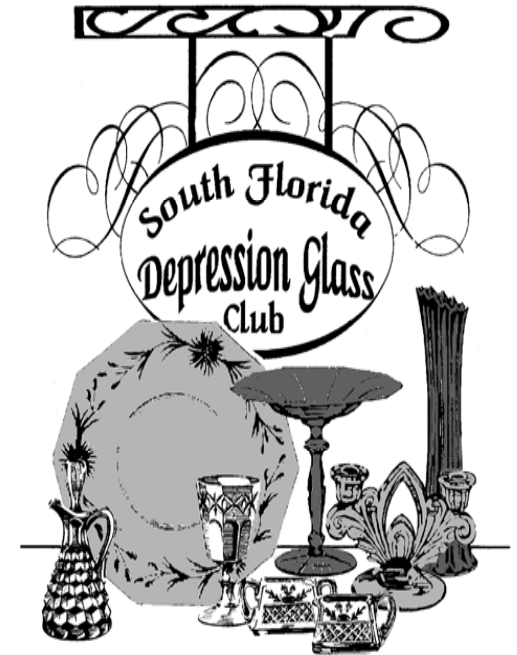

Each monthly meeting includes a program about glassware or pottery from the Depression Era given by club members or guest speakers.

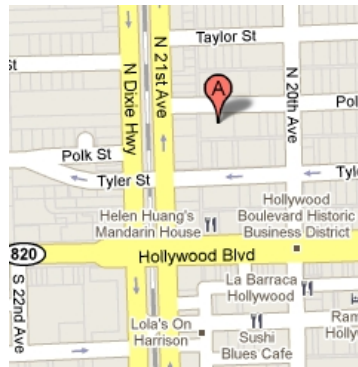
